Total cost of either the two year or four year program is \$14,000 for the 400 participation hours required by the AGD Mastership program. This includes all 20 monthly weekend sessions. Net cost is \$280.00 per day.

Paid on contract for 20 sessions as \$583.33 per month for 24 month program or \$291.67 per month for 48 month program.

Automatic credit card charges can be used, or payment by check. Accounts must be current to attend weekends.

There is no rebate for weekends missed but you may "make up" weekends when the subject is presented for a subsequent group.

A 10% discount can be extended for full payment prior to the first weekend.

Hands-On Mastership Experiences (HOME): A Continuum for Clinical Excellence



We all want to be the best clinicians possible, building a bridge of knowledge to clinical excel-

lence. But its hard and often expensive to find "hands-on" courses in the various disciplines of dentistry. And to acquire the required mix of participation CE hours for AGD Mastership normally takes several years of hunting. This program is designed to hone your expertise as a general dentist while providing a "turn key" approach to obtaining the mix of hours required by the Academy of General Dentistry for its Mastership designation. And fees for this program's courses (about \$235.00 per day of instruction) are generally less than half the expense of individual course offerings. Read on to see how this program can meet your continuing education needs.



How Does it Work?

20 hands-on participation courses over either a two or four year period.

Given once per month for ten months of the year in the two year program. Four year program attendees come to only five programs per year.

Each program meets for twenty hours on a Friday-Sunday at noon. Breakfast and lunch provided.

Coursework is subject matter balanced for AGD hours.

All courses are given at UNLV School of Dental Medicine.

Hours are reported directly to the AGD at the end of each session.

Course enrollment is limited : 20-30 participants act as a study group.



When Does "HOME" Meet?

The first weekend in the 24 or 48 month program is August 14 thru 16, 2009. (See back panel for an initial course listing.)

In the 24 month program the weekends occur in each month except December and July.

In the 48 month program weekends occur in August, October, November, February and May (or as needed by the practitioner to meet the mix of required hours).

All hours are reported directly to the AGD.

The schedule for weekends is published six months in advance, with at least one new weekend added each month. Weekend topics may change based on speaker availability but the mix of needed hours will be maintained.
